BC Re-affiliation & CWO	There have been some issues with the club's re-accreditation due to a Safeguarding training certificate not being accepted by British Cycling (BC). The policy was reviewed, and it is clear that the certificate should be acceptable to BC. MT to contact BC for clarification.  GS agreed to complete the British Cycling Safe Wheel training course in order to resolve the issue for this year.
